SHL – Response to AGM resolution by Mrs. Cai Mengke – a major shareholder of SHL

In her response Mrs. Mengke reiterated the statement that she had made at the previous general meeting dated January 5th, 2017, according to which she is not a controlling shareholder of the Company, and is not acting in concert with any other shareholders of the Company.
